Minutes of January 21, 2021 Meeting

Clay County Appraisal District Board of Directors meeting convened at 6:00 p.m., in the Clay County Appraisal District office building located at 101 E. Omega, Henrietta, Texas. - Item 178. At 6:00 p.m. Eddie Dunn called the Board of Directors meeting to order.
- Item 179. A quorum was established
- Item 180. <u>Public Access:</u> Terminated employee, Amanda Hollis, and her companion, Mark Ward were present and asked why they were not included on the agenda. They were told that the matter they wanted to bring before the board did not meet the criteria for being placed on the agenda or addressed in a regular board meeting.
